In 2015, a team of Spanish scientists tested body tissue from nearly 300 adults. They measured the amount of certain pollutants in these tissues. R They had higher levels of cholesterol, a major risk factor for heart disease, as well. Another study from 2003 found that people had an average of 53 cancer-causing chemicals in their bodies. (1) They also had an average of 62 chemicals that can damage the brain and 55 that can harm babies in pregnant women. In many cases, the amounts of these chemicals were so small that they were probably not hurting people. Nonetheless, scientists are concerned because most of these substances were created by humans, and (2) they did not exist eighty years ago. This proves that we have not only polluted the world—we have polluted our own bodies! But how?
